

February News from the Health Office

Physical Exams (PE) are required for students in Kindergarten and 6th grade. While most have been completed, there are a few “stragglers”. Dr. Tronetti will be at OE Elementary on Friday, February 23 to do PE free of charge. You will be notified if this applies to your child.

Dental exams are required for students in Kindergarten, 3rd and 7th grade. If your child has seen a dentist this school year, the requirement has been completed. A dentist will be available soon to conduct exams at no charge for those that have not met the requirement yet and again you will be notified if this applies to your child.

For those students that received a vision referral letter and have returned the appropriate paperwork, I thank you. One of the items I must report to the state each year is how many students were referred for further vision testing, and the number of referrals completed. It is important to notify the health office of the outcome of completed referrals (ie. Glasses prescribed, etc.) so an accurate report may be filed.
